

AANP Terms of Membership

1. Your Acceptance of Terms

Welcome to the American Association of Naturopathic Physicians

The following Terms of Membership (“TOM”) are between you and the American Association of Naturopathic Physicians and constitute a legal agreement that governs your agreement to pay all fees and charges associated with 12 months of membership and to provide all documentation necessary to complete the application process. You must agree to these TOM before your membership can be processed. You agree to these terms when you select a monthly membership. You should print or save a copy of these TOM for your records. “AANP” as used herein means the American Association of Naturopathic Physicians located at 4435 Wisconsin Avenue NW, Suite 403, Washington, District of Columbia.

Updates

The AANP may update or change these TOM from time to time and recommends that you review the TOM on a regular basis. You can review the most current version of the TOM at any time at <http://www.naturopathic.org/TOM>. If the AANP makes a change to the TOM, it will post the revised TOM on our website at the link noted. You understand and agree that your continued use of your Membership after the TOM has changed constitutes your acceptance of the TOM as revised.

2. Definition of Membership Types

Regular Members

A Regular Member is a naturopathic physician who is a graduate of an accredited naturopathic medical school.

Graduate Members

Graduates from the last four years qualify for a variably priced membership based on their year of graduation from an accredited naturopathic medical school.

Associate Members

These are licensed healthcare practitioners who are not naturopathic doctors, but wish to support the AANP and its mission.

International Members

International Members are individuals who qualify as Regular or Associate Members but reside principally outside the United States and its territories.

Student Members

A Student Member must be currently enrolled in an accredited naturopathic medical school.

Supporting Members

These are individuals or entities wishing to support the purposes of the AANP and do not fit into any other member category.

3. Joining Requirements

Regular and Graduate Members

In order to qualify for a membership, these members must provide with their application:

- A copy of their diploma from an accredited naturopathic medical school
- A copy of their state license or proof of membership in a state association

Associate Members

In order to qualify for a membership, these members must provide with their application:

- A copy of their credentials in the applicants' respective field

International Members

In order to qualify for membership as a naturopathic physician, these members must provide with their application:

- A copy of their diploma from an accredited naturopathic medical school
- A copy of their state license or proof of membership in a state association

In order to qualify for membership as a licensed healthcare professional, not an naturopathic physician, these members must provide with their application:

- A copy of their credentials in the applicants' respective field

Student Members

In order to qualify for membership, these members must provide with their application:

- A copy of their Student ID or
- Proof of enrollment in an accredited institution

Supporting Members

In order to qualify for membership, these members must provide with their application:

- Proof of endorsement from a licensed ND who is an AANP member

Faculty and Retired Members

In order to qualify for membership, these members must provide with their application:

- A copy of their diploma from an accredited naturopathic medical school

4. Payment

Payment Method

You agree to pay all fees associated with 12 months of membership. There are two options available for your convenience: annual and monthly.

Annual Fees Option

You agree to pay all fees and charges associated with 12 months of membership up front in one lump sum payment.

Monthly Fees Option

You agree to pay all fees and charges associate with 12 months of membership. If you elect the Monthly Fees Option, your membership will be automatically renewed at the end of 12 months. You must contact the AANP at least 30 days prior to your membership expiration date and request that it be cancelled if you want to terminate your membership. In the event that you do not pay for one month or more, you are required to pay the past due amount before your account can be reactivated. If you fail to complete 12 months of payments, you will no longer be eligible to select the Monthly Fees Option. Once you have paid all your past due payments, you will be able to renew with the Annual Fees Option.
